
Cacti Hanging Baskets

Cacti is a family of planting vessels, hanging planters, cocoons, and bird feeders. Cacti hanging planters and cocoons, available in various sizes, are sculptural and can be filled with different types of vegetation. For air plants that don't require soil, the cocoon is open, and they can be hung vertically or horizontally, as well as hooked together. For soil planting, the hanging planter has a solid bottom. The bird feeder can stand freely on a stand or be hung from a tree, pergola, or under a protective roof.

Materials and surface treatments	<p>Steel</p> <p>Nola uses high-quality steel with good strength in our products. Steel rusts if left untreated and must therefore be surface treated.</p> <p>Powder coating</p> <p>Powder coating is a coating that is applied as a free-flowing, dry powder. Unlike conventional liquid paint, powder coating is usually applied electrostatically and then cured under heat or with ultraviolet light. The result is an even, hard-wearing coloured surface with the desired gloss level.</p>
Assembly and placement	<p>Freestanding</p> <p>Freestanding product that is placed directly on the ground.</p>
