

Pylon Bench

Design Kristoffer Fagerström & Marcus Abrahamsson

Inspired by tall pylons supporting power lines, the base of the bench is formed by twin uprights that balance the seat between them. The seat is created by two layers of pine beams compressed into a solid length. Pylon is a perfect complement to cutting-edge interiors and contemporary outdoor spaces, or any setting where art and design take centre stage. A one-seater version is also available.



Dimensions and weight

Length: 205 cm alternativt 48 cm

Width: 40 cm Height: 45 cm

Individual dimensions:

The support posts are in 8 mm bent sheet steel which are hot-dip galvanized and powder-coated white RAL 9010.

The seat is made in glued stained pine, or alternatively, oiled ipé wood 70 mm x 70 mm.

Nola's pine is of high quality and comes from sustainable forestry. Pine is an environmentally friendly, domestically produced material. Damaged or untreated pine is quite easily attacked by decomposition processes; therefore, it is particularly important to repair damaged surfaces.

Assembly and placement

Freestanding

Freestanding product that is placed directly on the ground.

Surface mount

Can be bolted above ground, to the floor or to a cast-in-place foundation. Bolts not included.

Delivered fully assembled.

Versions

Available as a bench or a seat.

Character

Pylon is based on a traditional bench shape, which has been dramatically transformed into a striking contemporary design.
